Sacrament of Baptism

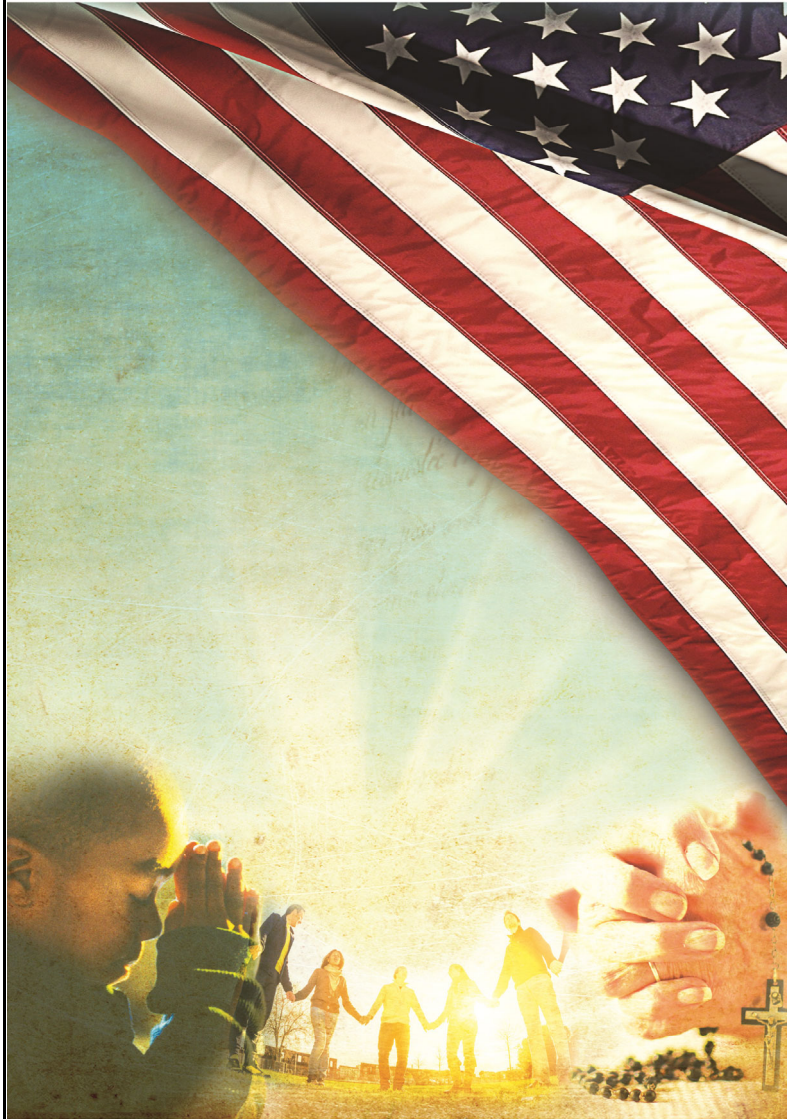
