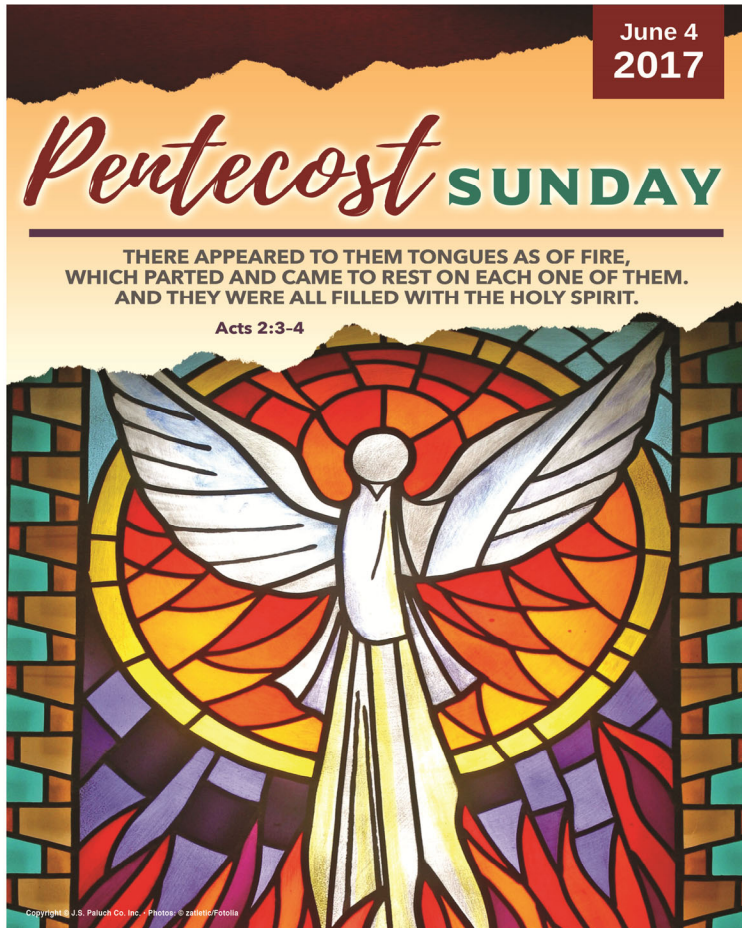

A Message from the Principal

The 2016-2017 school year as come and gone, and what a fast, wonderful year it was! On May 17th, we graduated twelve fine young people whom we know will go on to their respective high schools with the academic advantage, study skills, and the ability to make decisions based on that firm foundation of Catholic values and beliefs they've lived here at OLQP School for so many years! In early May our second graders received their First Holy Communion. They prepared long and hard for this Sacrament and were so excited when the day finally came! The busy month of May also brought such fun activities as the Talent Show and Field Day. I'm continually amazed at the amount of talent we have in our small school! Also, at the end of this school year Lisa Newell, the PreK 4 teacher for the past seventeen years, retired. Lisa was responsible for beginning the Preschool Program at Our Lady Queen of Peace. She taught both the 3 and 4 year old classes for the first 14 years until we began to offer full-time four year old Preschool. Mrs. Newell will be missed, and her dedication and years of commitment to Catholic education has been so much appreciated by all of us at Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish School!! We wish her the best in retirement!! Our 'STEAM' team continued the great work this year of providing Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math activities for all grades, PreK-8. Students at OLQP are learning how to think analytically, critically, and use those higher level thinking skills to give them an advantage when they move on to higher education and in life outside of formal education! For next year we will continue our focus on teaching important writing skills to our students throughout every grade level. We use the Lucy Calkin's Writing Program and have seen such positive results since we began using it. As always, we continue to teach cursive, and traditional math, infused with those higher level math skills students need to be successful. We have achieved such success in math in that our students by the time they reach 8th grade are performing at levels far above average, usually at the 75th-90th percentile, on standardized tests. We rounded out our new Science curriculum, which is interactive and hands-on at every level! It's been such a productive, successful year! Our small class sizes enable us to do so much with our students that schools with larger class sizes are unable to do! The individual attention given to each student is unmatched anywhere! As I close, I want to thank not only our parents for the financial sacrifice they make in giving their children the OLQP School advantage, but also all parishioners who support our mission in every way! Our Lady Queen of Peace is a special school and parish because of you!! I wish everyone a blessed , safe summer. Thank you for spreading the good word to everyone you know about our school.
