The 2017-2018 school year is just around the corner, and I am so excited for all it brings! We were able to complete the new interactive science program purchase throughout the grade levels this summer. This was used in grades K-4 last year, and this summer we purchased it for 5th and 6th grade. It's an excellent hands-on, interactive program that fits beautifully with what we are already doing with our STEM(Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) team. Over the last few years we have focused more than ever in making our students active participants in all their learning in all subject areas. Work with instructional technology has been going on throughout the summer also. When the first day of school comes around, all classrooms will be ready to go with interactive technology and one-to-one capability for students in grades 4-8. All of these students will continue to have their own personal ChromeBook/ laptop for daily use all year long. We also continue to focus on traditional methods of teaching math, cursive writing, and on our entire writing program at every level which focuses on teaching students to become proficient writers at all levels. This combination of using traditional methods of teaching together with our progressive curriculum has proven, per our standardized test scores and graduate performance, to graduate students who experience high levels of success wherever they attend highschool..... our small class sizes and the individual attention each student receives every day also plays a large part in the success our students achieve once they leave OLQP School!
