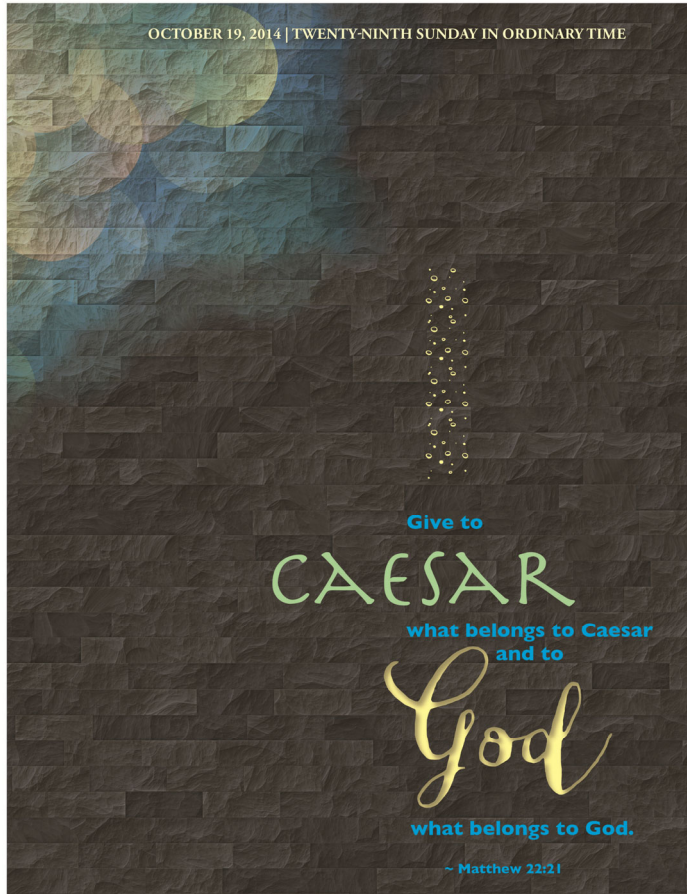

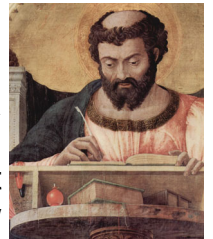

St. Luke

Feast Day—October 18

St. Luke was born in Syria and trained as a physician. He was also one of the most extensive writers of the New Testament. In addition to his gospels, he also wrote the 'Acts of the Apostles.' He was one of 'the seventy' and worked with St. Paul, traveling to Rome and converting Jews and pagans to Christianity. He was also with Paul during several of his confinements. Luke is also credited with being a prolific painter, creating many works of Mary and Jesus. He is known as the patron saint of artists, physicians and surgeons. He died at age 84 in Boeotia.

Dear Parishioners,

I am sure that many of us have been reading about the "seismic shift" in Vatican philosophy towards our brothers and sisters who are homosexual, or in civil unions, or who are cohabitating, or who are in second marriages after a divorce. The secular media would have us thinking that the Vatican is completely abandoning the teachings of the Church, but that is not the case. The Holy Father wants us to change the language that we use, but does not want us to change the doctrine of the Church. The synod that is meeting at the Vatican is proposing changes in "improving the pastoral application of church teaching", not in changing church doctrine. Cardinal Erdo, who is the relator (director) of the synod, said "Homosexuals have gifts and qualities to offer to the Christian community... without compromising Catholic doctrine on the family and matrimony ." Making all people feel welcome and part of our worshipping community is vital to the Gospel message. All people are created in the image of God, and thus we never judge them as individuals. However, we do not condone actions that do not conform to the Gospel message. Let us follow the Holy Father's example and open our arms to all of our brothers and sisters in faith without compromising our Catholic faith.
