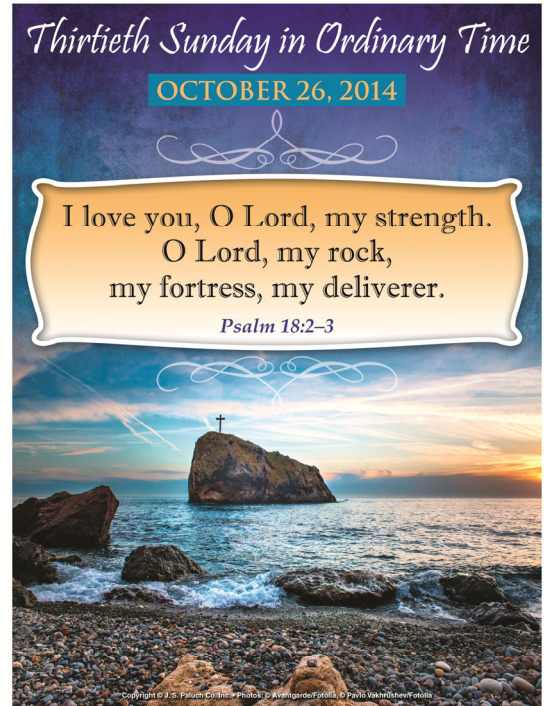

Dear Parishioners,

As I said in my last bulletin, the church was not going to change its doctrine, but that it was going to change how it spoke and approached these marriage and relationship issues. The Pope's final words forcefully address both sides in this debate. He said to beware of two extremes or temptations. One of the temptations he cited was that of "hostile rigidity" that seeks refuge in the letter of the law, "in the certainty of what we know and not of what we must still learn and achieve." This temptation he said, is characteristic of the "zealous, the scrupulous, the attentive and -today- of the so-called traditionalists and also of intellectuals." The second temptation addressed by the Pope was that of "destructive do-goodism, which in the name of a misguided mercy binds up wounds without first treating and medicating them; that treats symptoms and not causes and roots. It is the temptation of do-gooders, of the timorous and also of the so-called progressives and liberals."
